

Fort Campbell Shares C&D Waste Contract Management Education to All Installations

Fort Campbell offers the book, course, and soon, an online class to teach C&D waste contract management. For Fort Campbell, this initiative attacks a significant construction and demolition waste stream accounting for over 60% of total solid waste disposal.

Through this mandatory training series all Fort Campbell contractors performing construction, renovation, or demolition activities are trained through:

THE COURSE:

The Contractor Development Course, provided by the Army Corp of Engineers Nashville, is designed to educate contractors and subcontractors on methods for complying with Fort Campbell's debris reduction requirements and the ASCIM policy. The training focuses on Fort Campbell's specific needs and provides a debris management step-by-step guide detailing how C&D debris can be used as a resource rather than a waste stream. Course includes:
